

## SHELF LIFE / DATE CODE INFORMATION FOR CANDYRIFIC PRODUCT

Revised March 2022

## Julian Lot Code (Closed) Dating:

The Lot # is printed on the outside of every case and on each retail unit. This number refers to the date of manufacture.

Example Lot Number: L21420MY

Item was manufactured on the 214<sup>th</sup> day of the year. The 20 means it was made in 2020. The last 2 letters reference the factory where the product was made. See Julian dating grid below.

21420 = August 2nd, 2020 is date of manufacture.

## Shelf Life:

- M&M Chocolates/Skittles Candies = shelf life 12 months
- Dextrose (from Sweet Maple Ltd.) = shelf life 3 years/36 months
- Cocoa = shelf life 810 days (about 26 months)
- Organic Jellybeans = shelf life 18 months
- Gummies = shelf life 24 months
- Marshmallow (Deco version in kits) = shelf life 18 months
- Peppermint Stick = shelf life 24 months
- Popping Candy = shelf life 24 months

\*Note – All M&M products now include a "best by" date that refers to the candy shelf life.
